

# Teaching Historical Literacy for Civic Learning

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## TEACHER WORKSHOP

This PLO is a half-day professional learning intensive for middle and high school teachers focused on teaching historical literacy for civic learning.

**Teachers** will learn about principles of historical literacy instruction and ways in which to support students' civic learning.

Fifteen teachers will be selected for this PLO and will receive 15 SCECH and \$300 honorarium, **contingent upon submission of lesson plans.**

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## SCHEDULE

**August 8:** Teachers will attend an interactive workshop with the focus on defining historical literacy and drawing connections with aspects of civic knowledge and competencies.

**August 9-11 (9am - noon):** Each day, a guest historian will present and then lead a discussion, with the focus on helping teachers apply the presentation ideas into their lessons.

**August 12:** Teachers will work in groups to discuss constructing inquiry lessons with the knowledge and resources they have gained. Each teacher will be responsible for writing a lesson plan that will be linked on the Michigan Council for History Education website.
